## **Admission Policy /Procedure**

All learners wishing to be enrolled in our school must agree to the ethos and abide by the rules and code of conduct of the school.

Parents are urged to train up their children to uphold the vision and values of the school and conduct themselves in the manner that honours God, their teachers and their fellow learners in the school.

Parents need to bring their child/learner to school for assessment and complete the application form on behalf of their child/children.

A once-off Registration fee of R600 which is non-refundable is required on the day of Registration.

### **Requirement for Registration**

Admission age for Grade 1 is:

age 5 years turning 6 years by 30 June in the year of admission, or by the latest in the year in which the child turns seven.

- ⇒ Learner's certified copy of the birth certificate.
- ⇒ Learner's copy of recent school report
- ⇒ Immunization clinic card for the first time admission.
- ⇒ Copy of the parent's identity document
- ⇒ Documentation supporting the legal relationship with the learner where the parent /guardian are not the natural parent.
- ⇒ A transfer letter or report if a learner is transferring from another school.
- ⇒ Learner who is not a South African must bring certified copy of Birth certificate, valid Passport and a STUDENT PERMIT
